On October 17, 2024, a session was held at Dr. Ambedkar College in Nagpur on three different programs carried out by HCL-HHHF. - 1. **Make India Capable:** The students were introduced to MIC program, which focuses on soft skills training, Digital Literacy, Social Security Schemes, Placement Support at free of cost.
- UNICEF's P2E: The students were introduced and enrolled with the 3 different certifications
  on UNICEF's Platform. The need of 21<sup>st</sup> century skills and benefits of having these
  certifications were explained.
- Social Security Scheme: The students were introduced and availed with Ayushman Bharat
  card and given knowledge on its benefits. Students will also apply for their parent's ABHA
  card.
