SESSION: 2024-25

The Department of English actively engages in mentoring students across the Arts, Commerce, and Science streams. At the beginning of each academic year, after the admission process is completed, students are assigned to teachers for mentoring sessions. This task is managed by four full-time faculty members along with an equal number of CHB teachers. A structured schedule ensures that mentees meet with their mentors at designated times and records of these interactions are meticulously maintained.

The initial mentoring session is usually conducted midway through the first semester, while the follow-up session takes place during the middle of the even semesters. In the 2023-24 academic year, teachers guided students based on assigned lists, although, in some cases, students were allowed to choose mentors based on their comfort and preferences. Sharing these lists among faculty members helped in fostering better compatibility between students and their mentors.

These mentoring sessions focus on academic support, emotional well-being, personality development, and addressing various social concerns. Students often face challenges such as difficulty concentrating on studies, family issues, or environmental distractions, all of which are carefully considered by mentors. Teachers provide suggestions to help students manage these issues, including lifestyle modifications and active participation in social initiatives. They are encouraged to implement these changes, even gradually, to bring about noticeable improvements before the next session. Some students experience positive transformations, while others show progress over time.

Additionally, students benefit from improving their communication skills and engaging in department-led activities. Participation in such initiatives not only enhances their confidence but also provides them with opportunities to showcase their hidden talents, often leading to recognition and success in competitions.

Issues pertaining to NEW EDUCATION POLICY-2020 were handled during both the interactions.
