



BCA Department organized a brainstorming activity for the students of Semester I on 12th October 2022 at 1:00 pm in College Auditorium. Report on Visit to Deekshabhoomi, Dr. Ambedkar College, Nagpur

A visit to Deekshabhoomi on 14th December 2024, was organised for the students of BCA Sem 1 by BCA department, under the one week Student induction programme. Around 180 Students were present. Principal Dr. Mrs B.A.Mehere Mam briefed the students that Bhadant Anand Kausalyayan brought the branches of Bodhi tree from Sri Lanka as a memorial of Buddha's enlightenment.

Deekshabhoomi is in Nagpur, Maharashtra, a location regarded as a sacred place, prernabhoomi (inspiring land) of social revolution being atheist and preparations for social actions against class conflicts, discrimination, and inequality also the first pilgrimage center of Ambedkarite Buddhism in India. Millions of pilgrims visit Deekshabhoomi every year, especially on Dhamma Chakra Pravartan din i.e. Samrat Ashoka vijaya dashmi ("Mass Conversion Ceremony Day") and 14 October, the Memorial Day when B.R.Ambedkar embraced and converted to Buddhism here. His final religious act was to embrace Buddhism and envisioned making India the Buddhist nation a prabuddha Bharat. Today, the largest stupa in the world is erected in his memory at the site.

This site is holy to Navayana Buddhism as this is the place where Dr. B. R. Ambedkar converted to Buddhism along with 600,000 followers on 14 October 1956, Dhammachakra Pravartan Din. During visit Principal Mam explained in detail the "Hall of Inspiration: Dr.Babasaheb Ambedkar's Life and legacy"

At last Principal Mam told students how Meditation is a mental and physical course of action that a person uses to separate themselves from their thoughts and feelings in order to become fully aware. In Buddhism the person meditating is not trying to get into a hypnotic state or contact angels or any other supernatural entity. At last students performed meditation for 10 minutes.

The visit was successful and all the students enjoyed. All the faculties of BCA department were present.




How would you rate the guest lecture overall?


How well did Mr. Anil Tatode explain the concepts?





Report on Visit to College Library

A library visit was organized for the students of BCA Semester-1 on 13th December 2024. Students were informed prior to the visit and instructed some rules to follow while they enter the premises. Mr. Rajesh Lokhande, Librarian was communicated about the scheduled visit. Students were formed in a group of 20 students each and led by a teacher-in-charge accompanied by a staff member in library. Students were shown the stack areas and arrangement of books according to the specific subject/s. competitive books, reference section, personality development and general reading were also shown to the students. Mr. Rajesh Lokhande explained the students process of issue and return of books as well as rules to be followed in reading room. He also showed the students SOUL-online catalogue and book search facility available in the library. E-sources and other online facilitation counter, free internet surfing for students were also clarified. Student's queries were also answered.

Online Public Access Catalogue (OPAC) is provided to the users for accessing availability of books in the library. Students are adviced to use the OPAC extensively for searching the required books and journal articles. Students visited Reading Hall, and reference section of the library. The college subscribes to many journals and newspapers. The different subject sections are well-displayed, and every student is encouraged to make the best use of the library and reading room. Library has separate e-resources section with four computers and internet facility, where users can access INFLIBNET's N list, Shodhganga, Institutional Repository, Shodhgangotri and use open access database DOAJ.
