Report on Effective Teaching - learning by Shrikant Komawar

The HR Cell of our college organized a talk on “**Dynamics of effective teaching learning in contemporary age**” to address the growing concerns about effective teaching learning. The talk was organized on 17th April 2025 in seminar hall at 12:30.00 pm. The guest speaker invited was Dr. **Shrikant Komawar**. The HR lecture on “*Dynamics of Effective Teaching-Learning in the Contemporary Age*” offered valuable insights into how education systems must evolve to meet current societal and industry demands. The session was particularly focused on the **integration of skill-based legal education and the moral responsibility of educators** to nurture not just competent professionals but also **conscientious and law-abiding citizens**.

The speaker highlighted the following points

- The urgent need to move beyond traditional theoretical learning.
- Practical and **experiential teaching methods** were advocated, especially in legal education, such as moot courts, simulations, and internships.
- Law students must develop **practical skills**, such as legal drafting, argumentation, and case analysis, to become industry-ready.
- The role of the teacher has transformed from a “knowledge-giver” to a **facilitator and mentor**.
- Encouraging **critical thinking, questioning, and real-world problem solving** was deemed essential.

Moreover, the speaker advised teacher to use the term “Worship hours” rather “work load.” Along with this he suggested to organize some programmes such as “Life of a lawyer” for students.

In conclusion the lecture was a thought-provoking discourse on how teaching and learning processes must adapt in the contemporary era. With a strong focus on **skill-based legal learning and nation-building through education**, it underscored the **transformational role of teachers** in shaping not just professionals but well-rounded citizens. The session was a timely reminder that education is not just about imparting knowledge—it is about **inspiring purpose and ethical responsibility**.

This session began by an introductory address by the Head of the department Prof. Dr. Varsha Deshpande and it was conducted by Dr Vaishali Sukhadeve. All teachers enthusiastically participated in the session.
