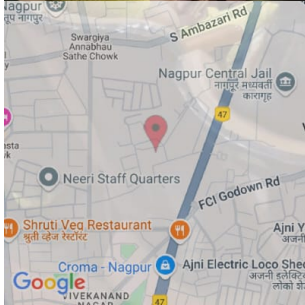
2. Keynote Lecture: "Ambedkar's Vision for Scientific India"

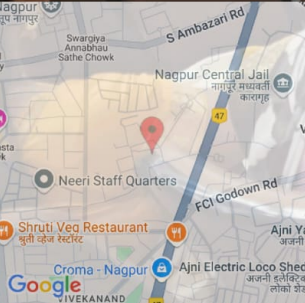

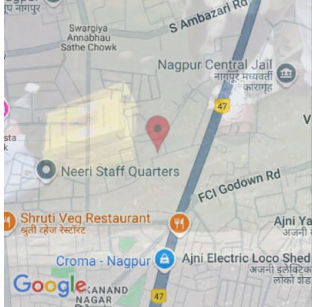

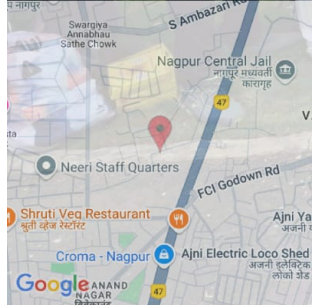
