
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

An interactive round table dialogue on vision & ideals that shape India was organized to commemorate the legacy of Dr B. R. Ambedkar, one of India's most influential social reformers, constitutional architects, and champions of equality. The dialogue aimed to reflect on his vision, ideals, and their on-going impact on modern India. This unique initiative of a dialogue in which teachers and students came together, was taken by the Department of Law to commemorate the 134<sup>th</sup> birth anniversary of Dr B R Ambedkar.

The event began with an introductory speech on Dr. Ambedkar's life and achievements by Head of Department of Law, Dr Varsha Deshpande. She highlighted Dr Ambedkar's Role in Drafting the Indian Constitution and delved into his contributions to ensuring constitutional safeguards for the marginalized and promoting the principles of liberty, equality, and fraternity. She spoke on the theme of Dr Ambedkar and Constitutional values.

The first speaker Mr Amol Ghotekar from final semester of LL.B course carried the discussion ahead by emphasizing the ideologies of Dr Ambedkar. Among few to note, he briefed the importance of education from the eyes of Dr Ambedkar. Importance of education especially to the women and marginalised society is the backbone of a civilised society. Mr Ghotekar then shared the vision of Dr Ambedkar on upliftment of Dalits & Womens Rights.

The second speaker Mr Sarvesh Kumar again from final semester of LL.B course highlighted several Articles from the Constitution that reflected the ideology as discussed by the first speaker. He went on to quote that 'Education that does not teach morality is no education at all' the brilliant person behind this visionary statement Dr Ambedkar.

The third speaker Ms Linta Thomson related the ideas of Dr Ambedkar in today's digital era. She gave the examples of digital platforms such as SWAYAM, e-Pathshala and so on which are upholding the values of Dr AMbedkar by providing education to the unreachable and under-privileged sections of the society. It is observed that The New Education Policy also reflects visions of Dr Ambedkar in empowering minds of the young.

Dr Pratima Lokhande then applauded the students for their research and participation. She concluded by mentioning that Dr Ambedkar's ideologies were revolutionary and continues to shape India's socio-political landscape. The unwavering commitment to justice, equality, and democracy has left an indelible mark on Indian society.

Lastly, Mr Akash Dhote contributed to the discussion by elaborating the use of AI to gain more information. He mentioned that when asked to one of the AI applications – How would Dr Ambedkar react to the current socio-political environment in India? The answer was astonishing because India is the only country in the world that values its minorities and it is the uniqueness of India that unity prevails despite existing in a varied diverse culture of

different languages, customs and lifestyles.
