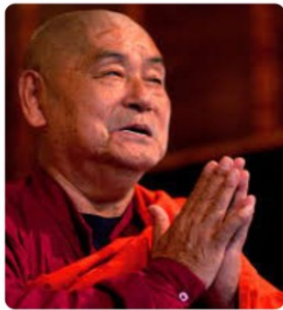

Report





On the occasion of 68th Dhammachakra Pravartan Diwas, a guest lecture was organised by Department of Commerce to have a discussion on “Opportunities & Challenges Before SC/ST Youth Today”.

The guest speaker was Padma Shri Dr. Milind Kamble, Founder Chairman, Dalit Indian Chamber of Commerce and Industry(DICCI); Chairman, Board of Governors, Indian Institute of Management, Jammu; Chairman, Advisory Board, National SC/ST Hub, Ministry of MSME, Government of India, whereas Pradeep Aaglawe, Member, Parampujya Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Smarak Samiti, was the chairperson of the programme.

Dr.Milind Kamble the guest speaker began with the example of a business person Nandan Nilkani and appreciated his business model. He then talked about Marginalised Community Capital. He stated that despite the challenges, this is the best time in India to pursue entrepreneurship.

To start an Enterprise, though it is not an easy, it is even more difficult to marginalized communities. Still many people from dalits has converted challenges into opportunities and now successfully running their business all over India. Earlier dalits were having only career option in government and private services, some of them into politics, but DICCI has helps lots of dalits to set up enterprise and open the avenue of entrepreneurship amongst dalits.

The country has developed a comprehensive ecosystem to support young entrepreneurs. According to the Startup India portal, over 100,000 startups have been registered, with 125 of them achieving unicorn status. These startups have collectively created around 20 million direct and indirect jobs, with the number expected to grow significantly by 2030.

Today, every college has an Entrepreneurship Development Cell (EDC), universities have incubation centers, and the Technology Incubation Centres set up by the Department of Science and Technology (DST) along with Atal Incubation Centres established by NITI Aayog, and state-led incubators are readily available to assist aspiring entrepreneurs. While all startups face challenges, SC/ST-led startups face double the hurdles. These challenges revolve around access to Markets, Money, and Technology (MMT).

The Government of India has recognized these issues and created a "3M Ecosystem" to address them:

****Access to Market:**** 1. 25% of procurement from SMEs, of which 4% is reserved for SC/ST entrepreneurs, 3% for women, and 18% for others (via the MSME SAMBANDH Portal). 2. Procurement through GeM (Government E-Marketplace). 3. Procurement from ONDC (Open Network for Digital Commerce). 4. Procurement through Khadi India. 5. Procurement from TRIFED. 6. Upcoming Unity Malls will provide opportunities for ODOP (One District One Product), Self Help Groups (SHG), and small businesses to showcase and sell their products.

****Access to Money:****

For the first time, 45 crore accounts of informal and small businesses have collectively received loans totaling ₹27 lakh crore without collateral. Initiatives like Stand Up India, Venture Capital Funds, Seed Funds, angel investor networks, and private equity players are active in the market. Previously, only institutional and private finance (with high-interest rates) were accessible, but now various financial instruments are available to support entrepreneurs.

In addition, the New Education Policy (NEP) is a game changer, with its emphasis on skill-based learning, multidisciplinary approaches, and multiple entry and exit points, further supporting the entrepreneurial ecosystem. India is moving in the right direction with tremendous momentum towards a Viksit Bharat by 2047.

During the event, Dr. Kamble felicitated the bright students of the college and releasing books authored by college professors. He acknowledged and appreciate the quality and academic excellence of the college. The program was

presided over by Dr. Pradeep Aglave, Member Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Smarak Samiti. Other members of the smarak samiti Shri. N.R. Sute, Shri. Vilas Gajghate were guests of honor. Principal, Dr. Bhuvaneshwari Mehre gave the welcome address and highlighted the glorious journey of college; The Program Coordinator CS Dr. Akhil Ramteke moderated the event as well as gave the introductory remark. 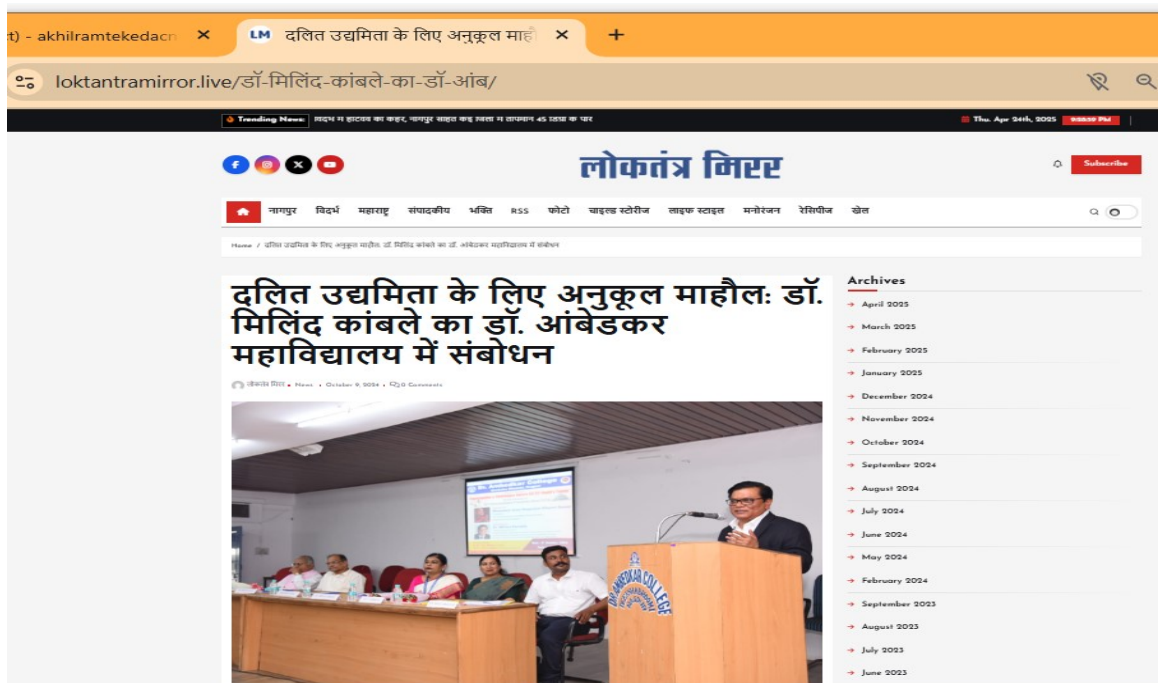

नागपुर. स्थित डॉ. आंबेडकर महाविद्यालय की 60 वर्षों की शैक्षणिक उत्कृष्टता की सराहना करते हुए डॉ. मिलिंद कांबले ने कहा कि किसी भी उद्योग को सफल बनाने के लिए ईमानदारी और निष्ठा का होना अत्यंत महत्वपूर्ण है। उन्होंने यह भी बताया कि उद्योग शुरू करना जितना चुनौतीपूर्ण है, उतना ही अधिक चुनौती दलित और वंचित वर्ग के लिए होती है। इसका कारण यह है कि उनके पास आवश्यक संसाधनों की कमी होती है, जिसके कारण उन्हें कठिनाइयों का सामना करना पड़ता है। फिर भी, कई दलित उद्यमियों ने इन चुनौतियों को अवसरों में बदलकर सफल उद्योग स्थापित किए हैं। दलितों को उद्योग शुरू करने के लिए वित्तीय साधनों की कमी, बाजार में प्रवेश, और सामाजिक पूंजी जैसी अनेक चुनौतियों का सामना करना पड़ता है। हालांकि, कुछ सरकारी योजनाएं, चैंबर ऑफ कॉमर्स का सहयोग, एंजल इन्वेस्टर्स, वेंचर कैपिटल, और उच्च नेटवर्थ व्यक्तियों (HNI) के नेटवर्क से इन सभी चुनौतियों को अवसरों में बदला जा सकता है। पहले दलितों के लिए शुरुआती चरण में फंडिंग एक बड़ी समस्या हुआ करती थी, लेकिन अब सामाजिक न्याय मंत्रालय

की योजनाओं और स्टार्टअप इंडिया जैसी योजनाओं की मदद से उद्योग शुरू करना आसान हो गया है। इसके साथ ही, MSME मंत्रालय की योजनाओं और गवर्नमेंट ई-मार्केटप्लेस की सुविधा से बाजार में प्रवेश भी सुगम हो गया है। डॉ. कांबले ने जोर देकर कहा कि शैक्षणिक संस्थानों को दलितों को उद्योग शुरू करने के लिए अनुसंधान, तकनीकी और प्रबंधकीय सहायता प्रदान करनी चाहिए। पहले दलितों के पास नौकरी, राजनीति, या छोटे व्यवसाय ही करियर के विकल्प हुआ करते थे, लेकिन DICCI (डिक्की) के सहयोग से अब उद्यमिता का तीसरा विकल्प भी उपलब्ध है। DICCI ने भारत में दलितों के लिए एक अनुकूल इकोसिस्टम तैयार किया है, जिससे वे इस अवसर का पूरा लाभ उठा सकते हैं। धम्म चक्र प्रवर्तन दिवस के 68वें वर्ष के उपलक्ष्य में आयोजित “दलित युवाओं के समक्ष अवसर और चुनौतियाँ” विषय पर मुख्य वक्ता के रूप में बोलते हुए डॉ. मिलिंद कांबले ने उपरोक्त विचार व्यक्त किए। इस कार्यक्रम की अध्यक्षता स्मारक समिति के सदस्य डॉ. प्रदीप आगलावे ने की। महाविद्यालय की प्राचार्या डॉ. भुवनेश्वरी मेहेरे ने स्वागत भाषण दिया। इस व्याख्यान का संयोजन डॉ. अखिल रामटेके ने किया। इस अवसर पर स्मारक समिति के सदस्य श्री सुते और विलास गजघटे, वाणिज्य विभाग प्रमुख डॉ. पानबूढे, और महाविद्यालय के सभी प्राध्यापक व विद्यार्थी बड़ी संख्या में उपस्थित रहे। अंत में, डॉ. राहुल कांबले ने आभार व्यक्त किया।
