OBJECTIVES:


- Students will be able to construct a well-structured and visually engaging presentation using computer software.

Tiger → Noun
 Jump → Verb
 Beautiful → Adjective
 City → Noun
 Sleep → Verb

Noun

- Definition (simple): A noun is the name of a person, place, thing, or idea.

Examples: Person → Riya,
 teacher/Place → school, park/Thing →
 book, ball/idea → happiness,
 love/Sentence Example: The dog is in
 the garden. (Dog, garden = Nouns)

Conclusion

- So remember:

Noun = Name
 Verb = Action
 Adjective = Description

Verb

- Definition (simple): A verb is an action word. Examples: run, eat, sleep, play, sing

Sentence -
 Example: The boy runs fast.
 (Runs = Verb)

Adjective

- Definition (simple): An adjective describes a noun.

Examples: big, small, red, happy, tall
 Sentence Example: The happy girl has a red dress. (Happy, red = Adjectives)

5. End with Summary

- Future tense = will + verb
- Used for:
 - - Plans
 - - Promises
 - - Predictions
 - - Decisions

1. Start with a Question

- ?? Can you tell me what you will do after school today?
- This will make them think in future tense.

2. Simple Definition

- Future Tense tells us about an action that will happen later, not now.
- We use 'will' + verb.
- Examples:
 - - I will study.
 - - She will play cricket.

3. Applications of Future Tense

- 1. To talk about future plans
 - ?? I will visit my friend tomorrow
- 2. To make promises
 - ?? I will help you with homework.
- 3. To predict future
 - ?? It will rain in the evening.

4. Quick Activity

- Ask 3-4 students:
 - ?? 'What will you do this weekend?'
- Students answer:
 - - I will...
