## OBJECTIVES:




- Students will be able to apply techniques for confident public speaking, including effective posture, gestures, and eye contact.

## What are Strong Verbs

- Verbs show actions or states.
- Strong verbs change vowels to form past tenses instead of adding '-ed'.
- This is called 'ablaut'.

Example  
walk → walked (weak verb)  
sing → sang → sung (strong verb)

## Verb Forms & Examples

### Forms:

- Base Form - present
- Past Tense - action in the past
- Past Participle - used with 'have' or 'had'

### Examples:

- sing → sang → sung
- swim → swam → swum
- begin → began → begun

## Why are They Important?

- Frequently used in daily conversations.
- Helps you speak and write naturally.
- Improves vocabulary and fluency.
- Practice makes remembering them easier.
