## REPORT

The department of Commerce organized a workshop titled “**How to Write Research Paper & Use of AI: Beyond Algorithms – Building Responsible AI Literacy in India**” for B.Com and M.Com second year students on 06th October, 2025 at Theri Sanghmitra Hall (Mini Auditorium) at 10:00 AM. Dr. Rajesh Timane, Professor and Head, Dr. Panjabrao Deshmukh Institute of Management Technology and Research - PDIMTR, Nagpur and Dr. Ashish A. Linge, Assistant Professor, Department of Business Management, CP and Berar College, Nagpur were the guest speakers.

Dr. Akhil Ramteke, Assistant Professor, Department of Commerce, addressed the student and faculty highlighting that Research and Field Projects are mandatory components of the B.Com and M.Com curriculum introduced by the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020. He formally introduced the guest speakers. He emphasized that the workshop was not merely theoretical but a necessary toolkit to enable students and supervisors to meet these new statutory requirements effectively.

First session begun by Dr. Ashish Linge, in his presentation, he emphasized the critical dimensions of effective research titles such as – subject, variables, sample characteristics, research design and problem statement. This framework ensures research titles are specific, informative, and clearly communicate the research scope to potential readers and reviewers. He also presented the standard structure of academic research papers with recommended length allocations.

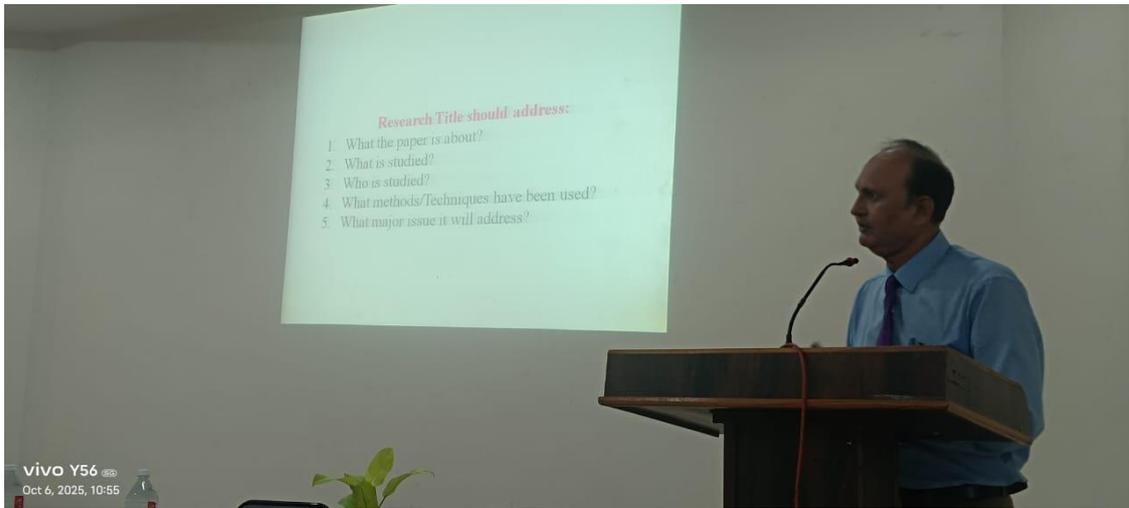
The second session was started by Dr. Rajesh Timane, he contextualized AI applications within commerce students' professional domains by stating few examples such as Automation of accounting and bookkeeping processes, Fraud detection and risk assessment in finance and Customer relationship management and data-driven decision-making. Later, Dr. Timane emphasized on Ethical Considerations and Responsible use of AI. He explained NITI Aayog's Responsible AI Approach for India which mainly consists of 05 points – Accountability, Transparency, Fairness, Privacy and Societal Impact.
