


Visit Details:


- **Date of Visit:** 19th July 2025

REPORT ON EDUCATIONAL VISIT TO CYBER POLICE STATION

As part of its continued commitment to experiential learning and legal awareness, the **Legal Aid Clinic of Department of Law**, Dr. Ambedkar College, Deekshabhoomi, Nagpur, organised an educational **visit to the Cyber Police Station, Nagpur, on 19th July 2025**. This initiative was undertaken to bridge the gap between theoretical knowledge of cyber law and the practical functioning of cyber policing in real-world scenarios. The visit formed a key part of the Department of Law's broader vision to provide students with exposure to contemporary challenges in digital crime prevention and the enforcement mechanisms that address them.

The session was conducted under the supervision of PSI Vivekanand Aoti, who welcomed the students and gave a comprehensive briefing on the structure and operations of the Cyber Police Station. The session began with an orientation on the complaint registration system, where students were walked through the procedural steps involved in accepting, verifying, and categorising cyber crime complaints. A live demonstration of the filing process was provided, allowing students to observe the workflow of case intake and preliminary analysis. Special attention was given to the use of the National Cyber Crime Reporting Portal (<https://cybercrime.gov.in>), a centralized online platform launched by the Government of India to facilitate public reporting of online offences such as financial fraud, online abuse, identity theft, and cyberbullying.

PSI Mr. Aoti, elaborated on the rising incidence of cyber crimes in the Nagpur district, explaining common types of offences such as phishing emails, fraudulent online transactions, hacking of social media accounts, and impersonation through fake profiles. He also emphasized the role of digital evidence in ensuring successful investigation and prosecution. Through interactive examples, he explained how elements such as metadata, browser history, transaction logs, and screenshots play a crucial role in substantiating allegations in a court of law. The importance of timely reporting and technical cooperation between victims, service providers, and law enforcement agencies was repeatedly underscored.

The educational visit was organized and attended by Coordinator Prof. Dr. Pratima Lokhande and faculty members Ms. Anusha Patre, Legal Aid Clinic representatives, and over Ninety Four students from the BALLB and LL. B program. The student participants expressed enthusiasm and gratitude for the opportunity to observe the real-time working of a cyber crime unit. Many remarked that the field visit deepened their understanding of how law enforcement applies statutory provisions in real-life situations, making the abstract concepts of cyber law more tangible and relevant. The faculty members accompanying the group noted the effectiveness of such visits in cultivating legally aware, technologically competent, and socially conscious law students.

In conclusion, the visit to the Cyber Police Station, Nagpur, proved to be a highly informative and practically enriching experience. It reinforced the importance of staying updated with technological developments in the field of law and underlined the responsibilities of legal professionals in ensuring justice in the digital age. The Department of Law remains committed to organising such field-oriented programs that contribute meaningfully to the holistic legal education of its students.


