The online Intercollegiate PowerPoint Presentation Competition, an activity under M.O.U. with Shri Binzani City College, Nagpur. for postgraduate students on 'Emerging Literary Research Trends in English Literature', was organized by Dr. Ambedkar College, Deekshabhoomi, Nagpur.

The activity was planned with the following objectives:

1. To familiarize PG students with contemporary and emerging research trends in English literature.
2. To encourage critical engagement with new theoretical frameworks and interdisciplinary approaches in literary studies.
3. To develop research-oriented presentation and academic communication skills among students.
4. To promote independent inquiry and scholarly exploration of innovative literary topics.

Evaluation Criteria

Judges assessed presentations out of 20 marks, with 5 marks each allocated to relevance of the topic, PPT design, Clarity of thought, and Delivery. Participants recorded 5-minute videos on suggested themes like Medical Humanities, Queer Literature, Post-colonial studies and other uploaded via Google Drive.
