Mohagaon Zilpi is a popular tourist destination; however, improper disposal of plastic, leather, and glass waste by visitors has caused significant environmental degradation. Such non-biodegradable waste adversely affects soil health, floristic composition, wildlife, and aquatic ecosystems. Plastic pollution, including micro- and nanoplastics, poses a serious threat to ecological balance and has emerged as a global environmental concern.

During the drive, students collected **20 bags of plastic, leather, and glass waste**, which were responsibly disposed of through a **local scrap vendor at Hingna**. The activity sensitized students to the harmful impacts of plastic pollution and motivated them to adopt sustainable and eco-friendly practices.
