PROGRAMME OBJECTIVE: To orient B.Com Semester-III students to the complete process and requirements of the compulsory Field Project as per the syllabus.

LEARNING OUTCOMES : To clearly understand the evaluation rubrics, the criteria for project assessment including UN SDGs, the mandatory report submission guidelines, and the essentials of conducting ethical and successful fieldwork.

REPORT

The Department of Commerce organized a Field Project Guidance Lecture for B.Com Second Year Semester – III Students at Theri Sanghmitra Hall (Mini Auditorium) on 12th August, 2025 at 10:00 AM. Dr. Akhil Ramteke, Assistant Professor and Dr. Sankalp Hadke, Faculty were the resource person. The Guidance lecture was divided into two parts.

The first part of the lecture was conducted by Dr. Akhil Ramteke. He explained the complete process for the Field Project which is a compulsory subject as per syllabus. He systematically explained the evaluation rubrics, which consist of 100 marks and is based on criteria of the description of UN Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) related to the project, respondent and community profile, application of theoretical knowledge, specific conclusions and recommendations, and feedback from the concerned community or organization. Furthermore, Dr. Ramteke outlined the report preparation and submission guidelines, emphasizing the need for a hard-bound copy, supervisor approval, and inclusion of certificates regarding originality and satisfactory completion of work from the respective field project guide allotted by the department.

The second part of the lecture was delivered by Dr. Sankalp Hadke. His session was focused on the critical role of the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) in the Field Project. He presented and briefly explained each SDG. Furthermore, Dr. Hadke provided essential general instructions for conducting ethical fieldwork, including practical advices such as taking consent from the community or individuals before taking photographs or collecting any form of data.

Dr. Varsha Panbude, Head of the Department, delivered a brief address. She emphasized the significance of the Field Project as an integral component of the B.Com curriculum and its role in bridging academic learning with practical fieldwork experience. She encouraged students to approach their projects with diligence and ethical responsibility, reminding them that their work contributes not only to their academic evaluation but also to meaningful community engagement and social development.

All the other faculty members Dr. D.H. Puttewar, Dr. Vaishali Fating, Mr. Ankit Pusadkar, Mr. Purvesh Fating, Dr. Dashrath Wasnik, Dr. Sarika Dhanokar Mrs. Nidhee Nakhale, Mrs. Poonam Vishwakarma, Ms. Abha Giri, Ms. Nanda Yadav and Ms. Pooja Kamble were present in the lecture.
