The workshop aims to create awareness and provide practical insights into various aspects of Intellectual Property Rights including Patents, Copyright, and related legal frameworks.

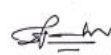

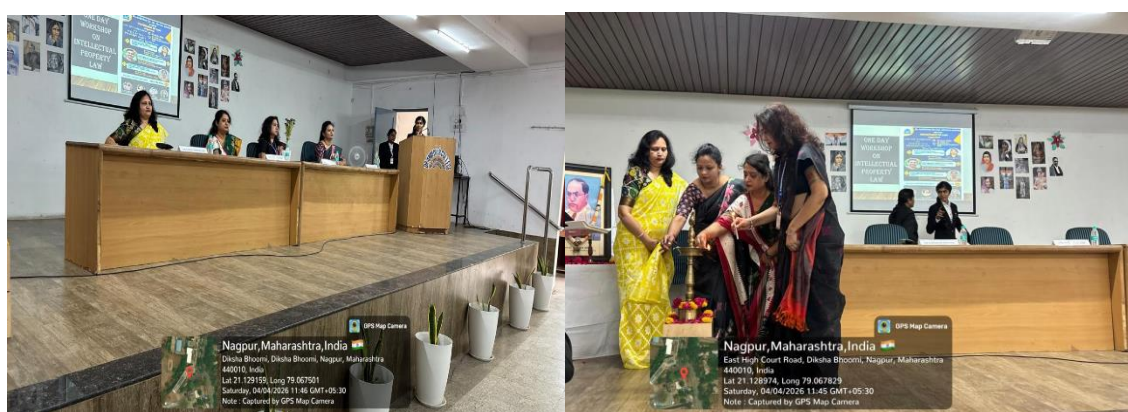

REPORT ON ONE DAY WORKSHOP ON INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS

The Department of Law at Dr. Ambedkar College, Deeksha Bhoomi organized a One Day Workshop on *Intellectual Property Rights (IPR)* on 4th April 2026 at 11:00 AM in Dadasaheb Kumbhare Hall. The workshop was conducted with the objective of imparting comprehensive knowledge and practical understanding of various dimensions of Intellectual Property Law within the Indian legal framework.

Registration for the workshop was conducted through a Google Form specially prepared for participants, which received an overwhelming response with a total of 207 registrations. While the workshop was made compulsory for students of LL.B. VI Semester (both 3-year and 5-year courses), it also attracted significant participation from students of other streams. Learners from Arts, Science, and Commerce disciplines enthusiastically registered and attended the workshop, reflecting the wide relevance and appeal of the subject across diverse academic fields.

The programme commenced with the ceremonial lighting of the lamp. The formal inauguration was marked by welcome addresses delivered by the Officiating Principal, Dr. Deepa Panekar, focusing on the need and importance of Intellectual Property Rights in today's time and thereafter, the Head of the Department (Law), Prof. Dr. Varsha Deshpande has addressed about the background of the workshop, Dr. Shilpa Rathod has given the introductory remark and highlighted the significance of Intellectual Property Rights in the contemporary legal landscape and emphasized the need for students to develop awareness in this evolving field. The inaugural ceremony concluded with the rendition of the National Anthem.

The First Session on “*Understanding Patent Registration under the Indian Legal System*” was delivered by *Dr. Priti Tayade*, Registered Patent Expert and Founder of Patent Masterkey. The session provided a detailed exposition of the procedural and substantive aspects involved in patent registration, with emphasis on the protection of innovations and statutory compliance. The session further covered the step-by-step procedure for patent registration, including filing of the application, publication, examination, and grant of patent. Dr. Tayade also highlighted the importance of conducting a prior art search and drafting a well-structured patent specification to avoid rejection.

Dr. Tayade began by explaining the concept and significance of patents as a form of intellectual property right, emphasizing their role in encouraging innovation and protecting inventors’ rights. She elaborated on the criteria for patentability under the Patents Act, 1970, namely novelty, inventive step, and industrial applicability.

Practical insights were shared regarding common mistakes made by applicants, timelines involved in the registration process, and the rights and obligations of patent holders. The session concluded with an interactive discussion, where participants raised queries related to patent filing and enforcement. Overall, the session was highly informative and provided valuable foundational knowledge to the participants, making them more aware of the legal and procedural aspects of patent registration in India.

The Second session on “*Copyright Protection and Legal Framework in India*” was delivered by *Dr. Divita Pagey*, Assistant Professor at MNLU, Nagpur. The session provided a comprehensive overview of copyright law and its relevance in the modern era.

Dr. Pagey discussed the statutory framework governing copyright in India under the Copyright Act, 1957, explaining the nature and scope of copyright protection. She elaborated on ownership rights, authorship, and the bundle of rights available to copyright holders.

The session also highlighted contemporary challenges in the digital domain, including issues related to online infringement, piracy, and protection of digital content. Overall, the session was informative and helped participants understand both the legal provisions and emerging issues in copyright law in India.

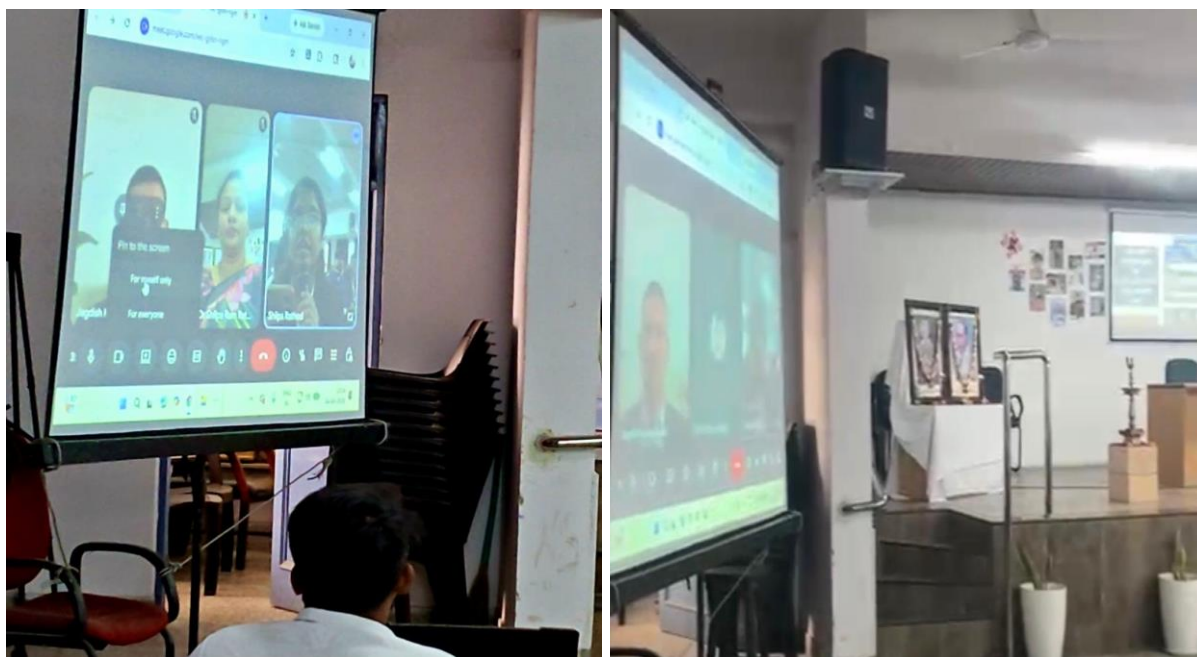

The third session on “*Infringement of Patents in India: Law, Policy and Practice*” was conducted by *Dr. Jagdish Khobragade*, Associate Professor at MNLU, Mumbai. The said session was delivered in online mode. The resource person elaborated upon the legal framework governing patent infringement in India, including available remedies, judicial interpretations, and practical challenges encountered in enforcement.

Dr. Khobragade elaborated on the legal framework governing patent infringement under the Patents Act, 1970, explaining what constitutes infringement and how rights of patent holders are protected. He discussed various remedies available to patentees, including injunctions, damages, and account of profits, along with important judicial interpretations that have shaped the law in this area.

The session also addressed practical challenges in enforcement, such as delays in litigation, evidentiary issues, and complexities in proving infringement. Overall, the session was highly informative and helped participants gain both theoretical and practical insights into patent infringement in India.

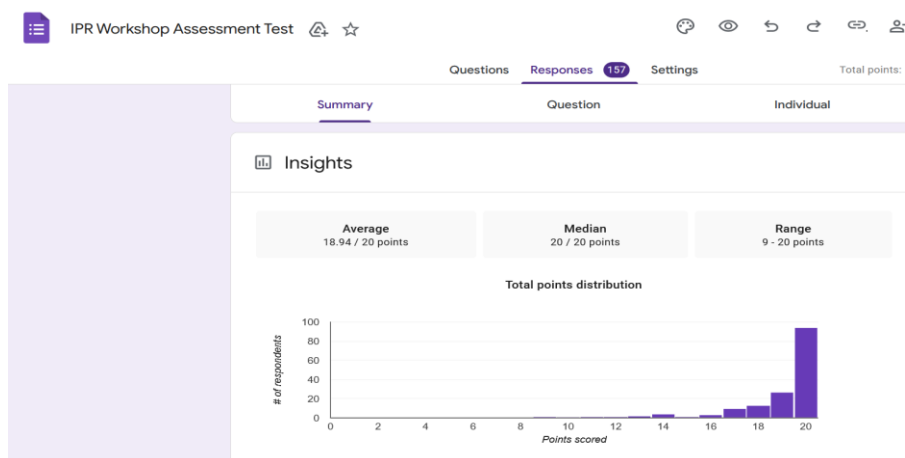

In order to evaluate the comprehension and retention of the participants, an assessment test was conducted after the third session through Google Forms based all the deliberations of three sessions delivered.

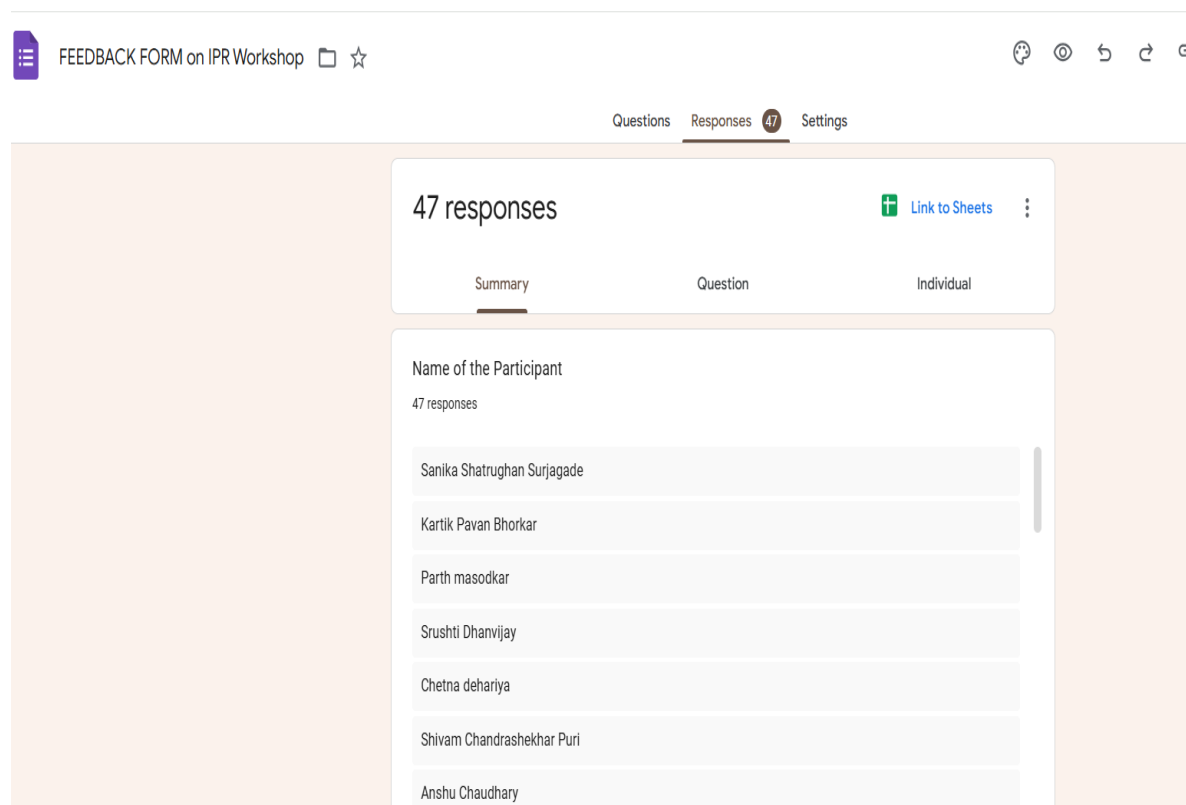
ASSESSMENT RESULT

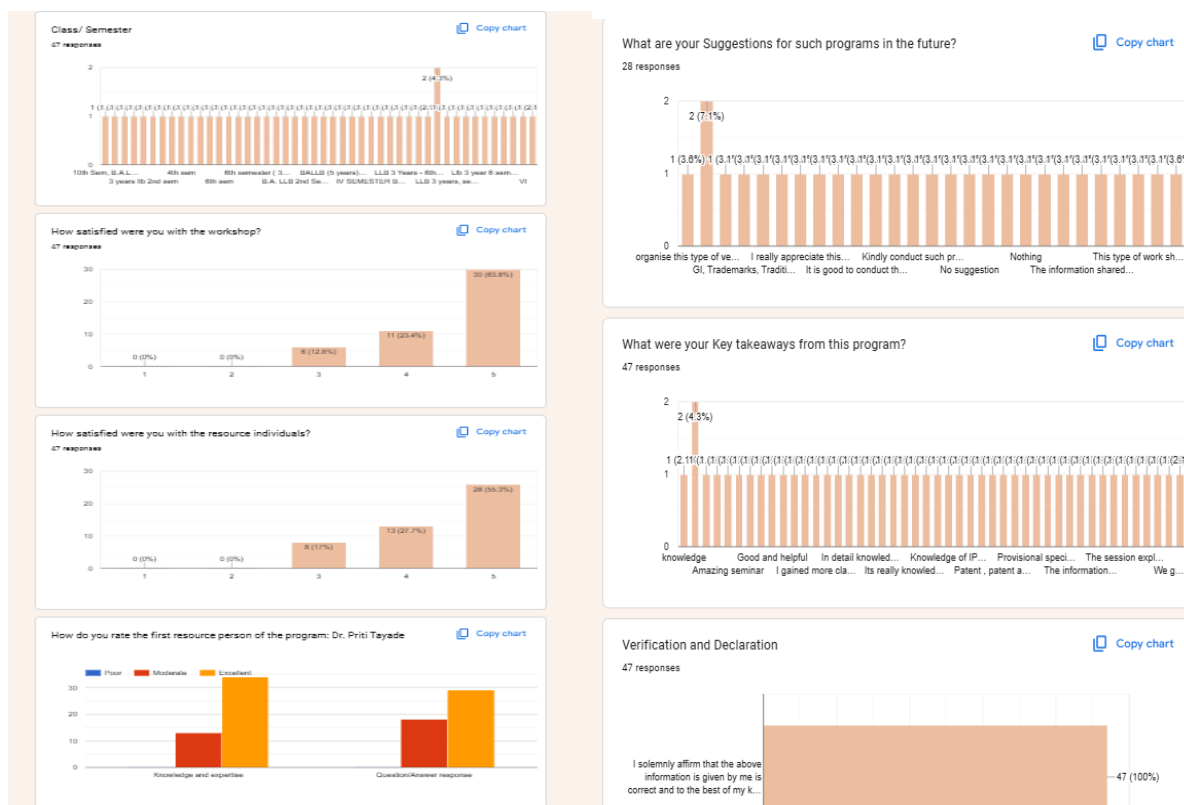
FEEDBACK FORM FROM THE PARTICIPANTS
