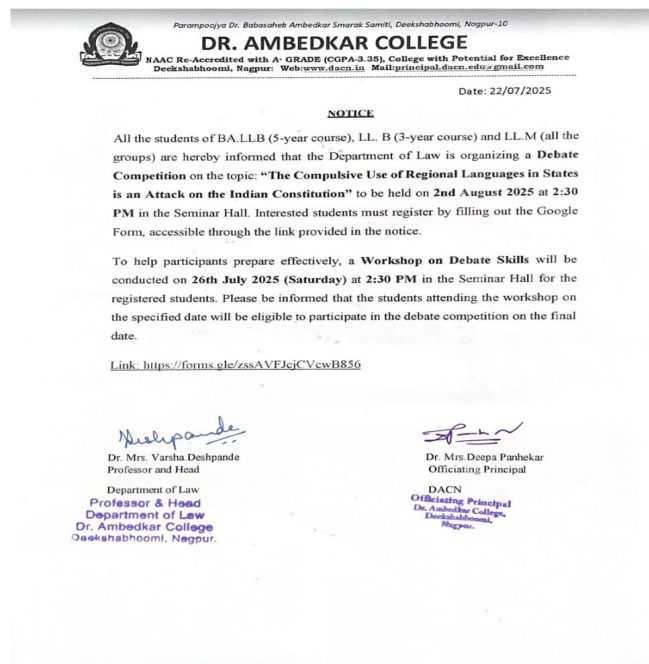

WORKSHOP ON PUBLIC SPEAKING FOR LEGAL PROFESSIONALS ON DEBATE SKILLS
