Women are victorious

The **International Women's Day program** was organized on **14 March 2026** at 11:00 AM by the American Chemical Society in collaboration with the Department of Physics and the Women Development Cell of Dr. Ambedkar College, Deeksha Bhoomi, Nagpur. The theme of the program was ***"Empowered Women, Empowered Nation."*** The event aimed to spread awareness about women's empowerment, gender equality and the role of women in building a progressive society.

The program began with paying homage and seeking the blessings of Lord Buddha and Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar symbolizing the ideals of equality, justice and human dignity. The Chief Guest **Dr. Trishali Dhemre**, Gynaecologist, District Hospital was warmly welcomed by the Principal, **Dr. Mrs. Deepa Panhekar**.

Dr. Vidya Choupagar, Coordinator of the Women Development Cell delivered the preamble and also released the magazine ***"Dnynbodhi"*** In her address, she highlighted that the celebration of Women's Day is not limited to a single day but is a way to acknowledge and appreciate the contributions and achievements of women throughout the month. She emphasized the importance of remembering the contributions of pioneers of women's liberation such as Savitribai Phule. She also spoke about the struggles and voices of Dalit women writers and activists like Urmila Pawar and Ruth Manorama, who have highlighted the issues faced by marginalized women.

Dr. Choupagar further explained that the roots of women's empowerment can be traced back to the teachings of Lord Buddha, where women were given respect and recognition, as reflected in the Therigatha. She also mentioned that Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar provided constitutional justice and rights to women, strengthening the foundation for gender equality. She appreciated the students for writing in the newly released ***"Dnynbodhi"*** publication and encouraged them to continue expressing progressive thoughts through writing and social awareness.

The Chief Guest, Dr. Trishali Dhemre, Gynecologist from the District Hospital, delivered an enlightening lecture on ***Adolescent Health Awareness***. She emphasized that a woman's life is a precious gift and that every woman should take responsibility for preserving her health and dignity. She spoke about the continuing challenges of gender discrimination in society and encouraged young women to become confident, aware and self-reliant.

Dr. Dhemre elaborated on the concept of adolescence, explaining the different stages of adolescent development and the physical, emotional and psychological changes that occur during this phase. She discussed the various challenges faced by adolescents and suggested ways to address them through awareness, communication and proper guidance. She stressed the importance of sex education stating that it helps young people understand their bodies, make responsible decisions and protect their health. According to her, adolescents play a crucial role in the economic growth and future development of the country and their participation in society is essential. She concluded by stating that the future of society depends on the quality, health and awareness of adolescents in the community.

Dr. Nitin Katode, Assistant Doctor from the District Hospital, also addressed the gathering and spoke about life skills. He highlighted the importance of developing essential skills such as communication, decision making, problem solving, emotional intelligence and self confidence among students. He encouraged students to cultivate positive attitudes and practical abilities that would help them lead successful and responsible lives.

The program was presided over by **Dr. Mrs. Deepa Panhehar**, Principal of Dr. Ambedkar College. In her presidential address, she spoke about the significance of International Women's Day and the need to promote gender equality in every sphere of life. She emphasized that empowered women contribute significantly to the development of families, communities and the nation. She encouraged students to follow the inspirational thoughts of great social reformers and to work towards creating a society where women are respected, educated and given equal opportunities. She also motivated the students to pursue education, self-reliance and leadership so that they can become agents of positive social change.

On the occasion of International Women's Day, several creative and educational competitions were organized for students including Scientific Skit and Scientist Character Portrayal. The judges for the Scientist Character Portrayal event were **Dr. Subhash Somkuwar** and **Dr. Deorat Begde**. Students enthusiastically portrayed the characters of renowned personalities such as Anandibai Joshi, Marie Curie, C. V. Raman, Vikram Sarabhai, Daisy Thomas, Alfred Nobel, Sudha Murthy etc presenting their contributions and inspiring journeys.

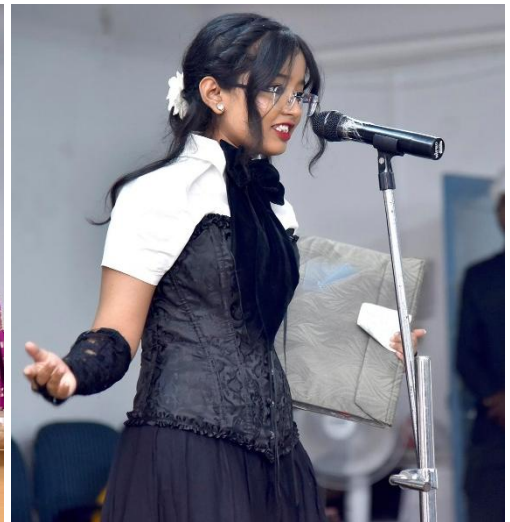
