Report on
‘Deeksharambh’ Programme
(12th August, 2026)

The Department of Statistics, Dr. Ambedkar College, Nagpur, organized the ‘Deeksharambh’ programme for the newly admitted B.Sc. Semester I students on 12th August 2026 in the Statistics Laboratory. The initiative aimed to ease the transition into college life, familiarize freshers with their academic framework, and build a welcoming departmental community.

The session commenced with a warm welcome from faculty member and senior students, followed by structured briefing sessions:

- **Academic Orientation**
 - ✓ A comprehensive overview of the **B.Sc. Semester I syllabus (Major Statistics)** was provided.
 - ✓ The **examination pattern** and **structure** for both **internal** and **external** assessments were explained in detail.
- **Departmental Activities:** Students were introduced to various departmental activities, including academic programmes and extracurricular events.
- **Code of Conduct:**
 - ✓ Emphasis was laid on maintaining **discipline, decorum** and **active participation** in academic as well as co-curricular activities.
 - ✓ It was highlighted that learning statistics requires rigorous *self-practice* and *self-note-making* rather than rote learning. Students were encouraged to assess their genuine aptitude, foundational skills, and self-interest for the subject.
- **Student Integration**
 - ✓ **Socialization:** The programme facilitated interaction among new students, senior students, and faculty members, helping them build a sense of belonging.
 - ✓ **Association:** Students were familiarized with the college and university environment, different departments etc.
 - ✓ **Governing:** The faculty guided students about the **institutional rules, regulations** and the **support systems** accessible to them.

The session concluded with an interactive **Question & Answer round**, where students raised queries regarding academics, departmental activities, and general college procedures. Faculty member and senior students responded to their concerns and encouraged them to actively engage in their academic journey.

The ‘Deeksharambh’ programme proved to be an enriching experience, helping students begin their new phase of education with clarity, confidence, and enthusiasm.
